Entrance Requirements for TSTC

- Requires a two-year commitment for both Junior and Senior year.
- Application and counselor approval required.
- Parent permission
- Teacher recommendations
- Students must be passing all classes and must be in good standing with daily attendance and campus discipline.
- Students are required to pay the costs of tuition, fees, and needed equipment.

Tuition, Books, and Transportation

- The student and parent/guardian will be responsible for tuition fees as low as \$33 per credit hour and for any books required for courses at TSTC. (Tuition approx. \$100 per semester)
- There may be clothing and tool purchases that will be required for courses at TSTC.
- Life School will be providing transportation to TSTC for Life School students and students will be required to use the transportation that Life School offers.
- There may be additional fees for TSTC campus fees, toolkits, shoes, books, etc., that student/parent/guardian will be responsible for paying.

REFUND Policy

To avoid any tuition charges, review your schedule and make necessary changes prior to the first-class day of the semester. Prior to the first class day of semester 100% refund.

TSTC Application Timeline

- **February** Counselors will meet with current sophomores to discuss the program. Applications open to all 10th grade students only.
- **March** Applications are due. Late submissions will not be accepted. Limited space.
- **April** Life School application decisions made. TSTC registration process sent out.
- **May** TSTC Acceptance Letters and What to do Next sent out.
- **June** Tuition due to Life School in full. (\$33 credit hour plus college campus fees)
- **August** Student must have all required materials purchased by the first day of class (textbooks/tools).

How do I get my student enrolled?

- Student must apply end of 10th grade year and meet entrance requirements for the program. Two-year commitment.
- Applications will be accepted and due end of March.
- Accepted students will be given specific instructions on how to apply with TSTC and submit bacterial meningitis shot record and transcript.
- Payments will be paid to LHSW by due date. No refunds after the first day of class.
- Students will be given specific toolkit list, textbooks, and advised on proper attire as required for certain pathways.

What to Expect?

- Students will complete modules on LHSW campus under supervision of an instructor.
- Student will get hands-on training at TSTC on designated days. LHSW will provide transportation to and from campus.
- Students must make 80 on modules to proceed to next level. Grades A, B, or F only and will be transcribed. Failing students will be dropped from TSTC Dual Enrollment.
- Student attendance, behavior, and grades will be strictly enforced. Student will be treated as a college student.
